
- 1. You should have the following for this examination:
 - (a) Plain medium weight fabric $\frac{3}{4}$ metres by 152 cm.
 - (b) Interfacing 60 cm by 50 cm.
 - (c) One button 1.5 cm diameter without shank.
 - (d) Casual shirt blocks (without sleeve) for a boy age 9 years in full scale.
 - (e) Sewing thread to match the fabric.
 - (f) Brown papers.
 - (g) One large envelope.
- At the end of the examination:
 - (a) Stack on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details.
 - (b) Enclose the garment in the large envelope.

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TASKS

- 1. Using the shirt flat block and the measurements provided, produce final patterns for the garment style sketched below.
 - **NB:** Spend minimal time on preparation of patterns.
- 2. Using the prepared patterns and the materials provided, cut out and make the garment as follows:
 - (a) use plain open seams at the shoulders and sides;
 - (b) make one hand worked buttonhole and sew on the button;
 - (c) under stitch the armhole facings;
 - (d) hand hem the back hem.



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
