INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. You should have the following items for this examination;

- (i) flat jacket and sleeve blocks age 11 in full scale;
- (ii) plain medium weight fabric $1\frac{1}{2}$ metres long by 152 cm wide;
- (iii) fusible interfacing 70 cm by 49 cm;
- (iv) two buttons 2 cm diameter without shanks;
- (v) thread to match the fabric;
- (vi) sewing tools;
- (vii) brown papers;
- (viii) one large envelope;
- (ix) tracing wheel;
- (x) glue / sellotape;
- (xi) a pair of paper cutting scissors;
- (xii) HB / 2H pencils;
- (xiii) eraser;
- (xiv) 1 metre ruler / square.

2. At the end of the examination:

- (a) stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details;
- (b) enclose the garment in the large envelope provided and hand it over to the examiner.

Candidates should check the question paper to ascertain that both pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.

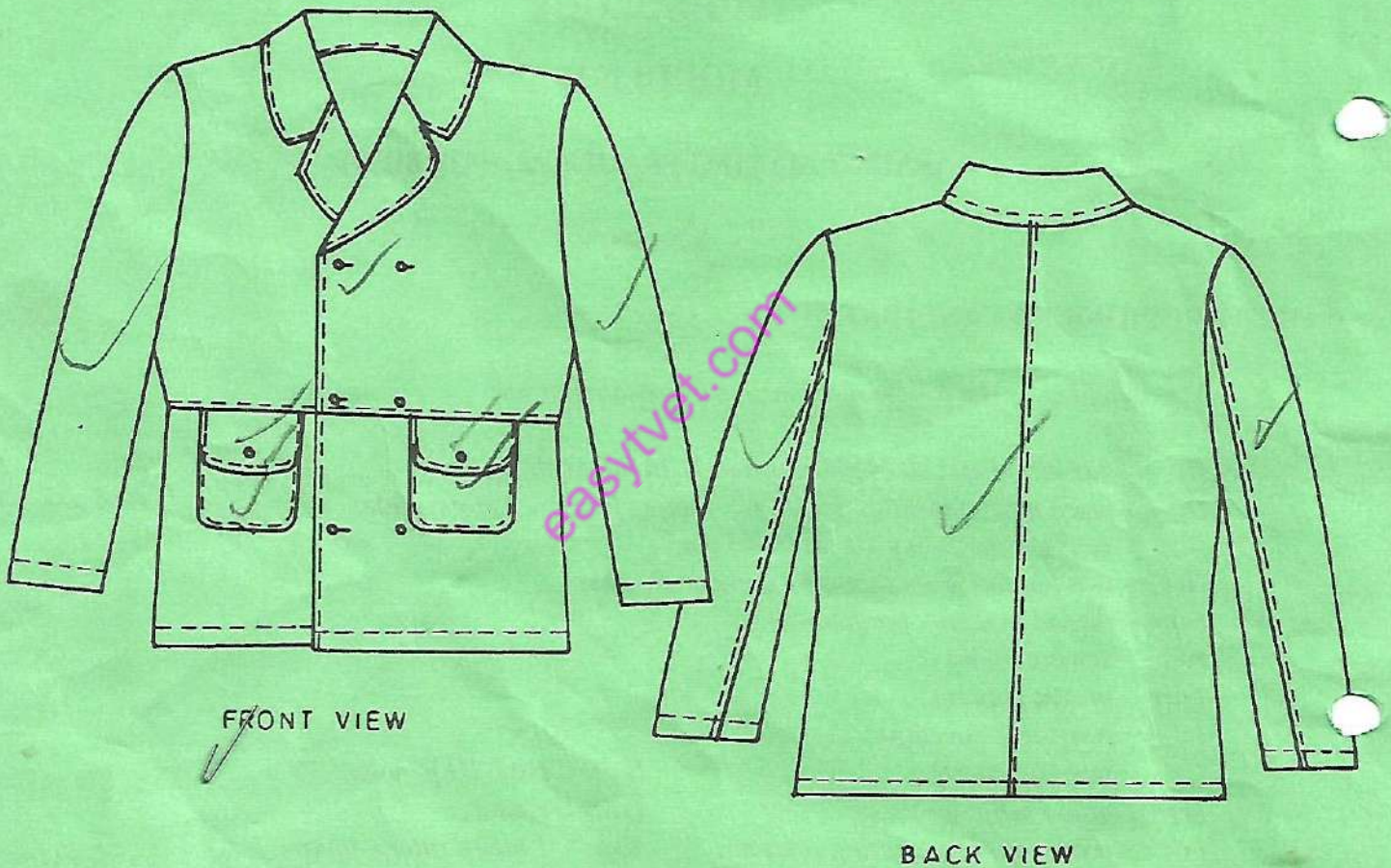
TASKS

1. Using the blocks and the measurements provided, produce final patterns for the garment style sketched below.

NB: (i) No underarm seams.
(ii) Spend minimal time on preparation of patterns.

2. Using the prepared patterns and the materials provided, cut out and make the garment as follows:

- (a) use plain closed seams at the shoulders and the sides;
- (b) make two buttonholes at the top of the opening and sew on the buttons.

Sleeve length - 51 cm
Full length - 53 cm

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
