INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. You should have the following items for this examination:
 - (a) Plain medium weight fabric $1\frac{1}{4}$ metres long by 152 cm wide;
 - (b) Easy fitting bodice and sleeve blocks size 8 in full scale;
 - (c) Sewing thread to match the fabric;
 - (d) One button 1.5 cm wide without shank;
 - (e) Brown papers;
 - (f) Fusible interfacing 50 cm by 60 cm;
 - (g) Pattern production tools;
 - (h) Sewing tools;
 - (i) One large envelope.

2. At the end of this examination:
 - (a) Stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details.
 - (b) Enclose the garment in the large envelope.

This paper consists of 3 printed pages.

Candidates should check the question paper to ascertain that all the pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.

TASK

1. Using the bodice blocks, sleeve blocks and the measurements provided, produce final patterns for the garment style sketched below.



FRONT VIEW



BACK VIEW

NB:

- Spend minimal time on preparation of patterns.
- Front facing is extended.

2. Using the prepared patterns and the fabric provided, cut out and make the garment as follows:
- (a) make plain open seams at the shoulders, side and underarm.
 - (b) make plain closed seams at the panels.
 - (c) use a crossway strip to fix the collar.
 - (d) slip hem the sleeves.
 - (e) make one button hole at the neckline and attach the button.

Measurements:

Blouse full length	-	51 cm
Top arm	-	28 cm
Sleeve length	-	19 cm
Pleat depth	-	3 cm
