

TASK 2

Figure 1 shows the design of a serving tray. Use it to answer the questions that follow:

- (a) Open a CAD program and change the units to millimeters. (1/2 marks)
- (b) Insert three layers with the following properties:
 - (i) Drawing layer; line weight of 0.8mm; (1 mark)
 - (ii) Centre line layer; blue in colour, centre line type; (1 mark)
 - iii) Dimensions layer; red in colour, line weight of 0.15mm. (1 mark)
- (c) (i) Draw the serving tray on the drawing layer using the dimensions given. (8 marks)
 - (ii) Draw the centerlines on the center line layer. (1 mark)
 - (iii) Fully dimension the serving tray on the dimensions layer. (6 marks)
- (d) Save the drawing as Tray in the KNECEXAM folder. (½ mark)
- (e) Open layout 1, balance the serving tray on the layout paper and print it. (1 mark)



TASK 3

Figure 2 shows a publication designed using a DTP program. Use it to answer the questions that follow:

- (a) Open a desktop publishing program and make the following page settings:
 - (i) Page orientation: landscape;

(ii) Paper size A4.

(½ mark)

- (b) Create the publication to appear as shown in Figure 2, ensuring the publication covers the entire area of the page size. (18 Marks)


