- (vii) sewing tools.

2. At the end of the examination:

- (a) Stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details.
- (b) Enclose the garment in the large envelope.

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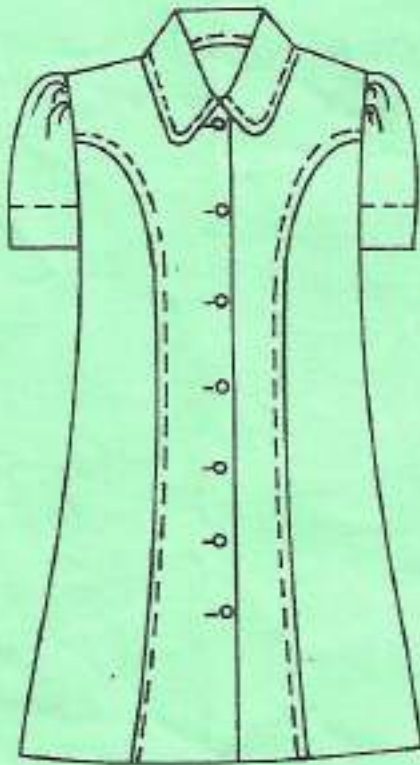
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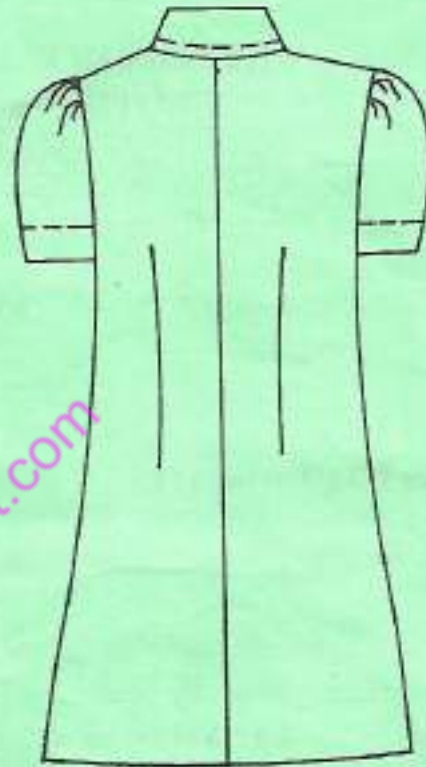
## TASKS

Using the measurements and the materials provided, cut out and make the dress style sketched below as follows:

- (a) use the plain closed seam at the sides, shoulders and underarms;
- (b) make one hand worked buttonhole and sew on the button;
- (c) hand hem the garment;
- (d) cut separate facings and understitch.
