 - (ii) fusible interfacing 40 cm by 32 cm;
 - (iii) thread to match the fabric;
 - (iv) zip 30 cm long;
 - (v) brown papers;
 - (vi) sewing tools;
 - (vii) one large envelope.

2. At the end of the examination:
 - (a) stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details.
 - (b) enclose the garment in the large envelope provided.

Candidates should check the question paper to ascertain that both pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.

Using the measurements and the materials provided, cut out and make the dress style sketched below as follows:

- (i) use French seams at the shoulders, sides and underarms;
- (ii) under stitch the neckline facings.
